Event Scope

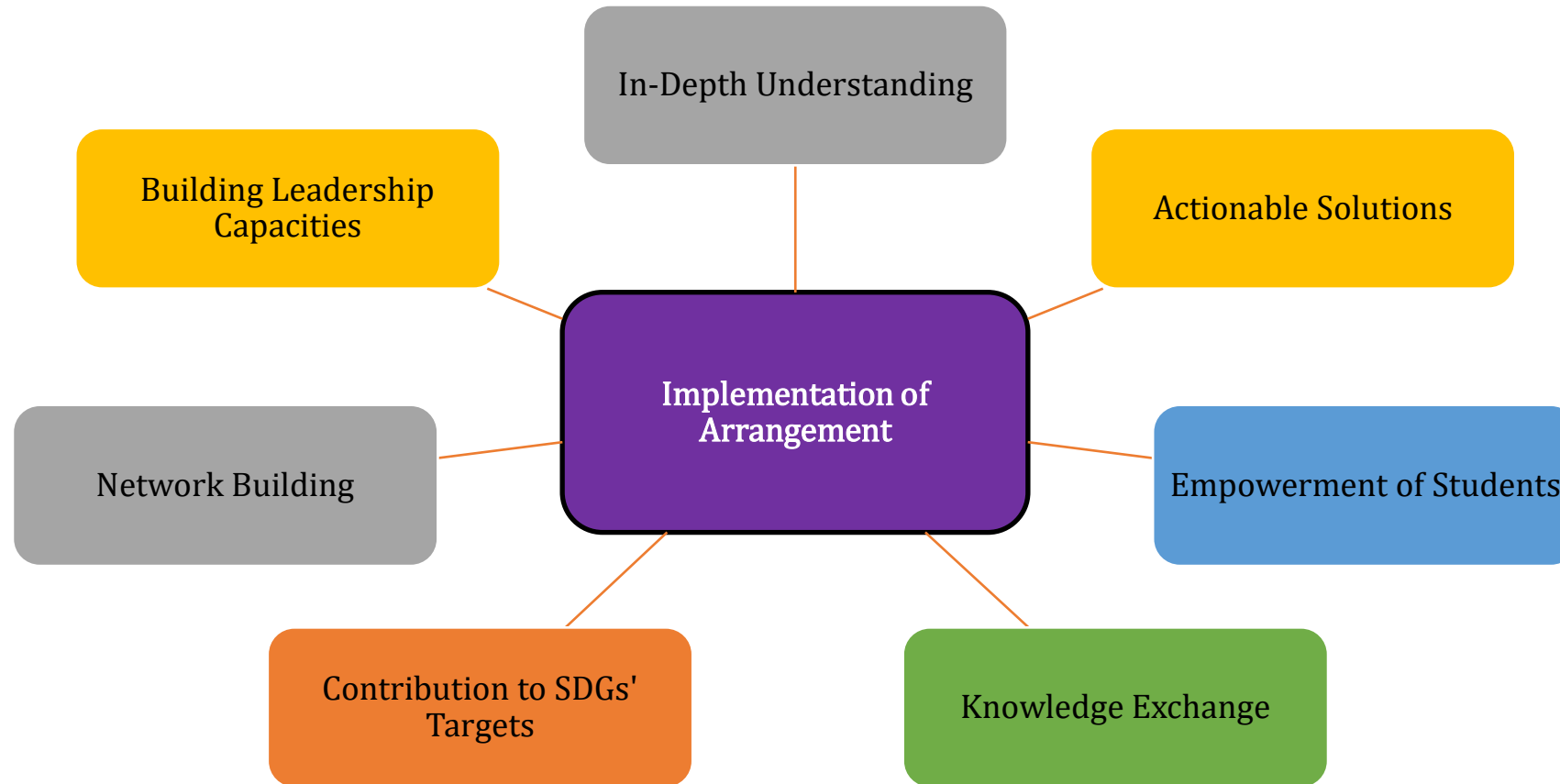

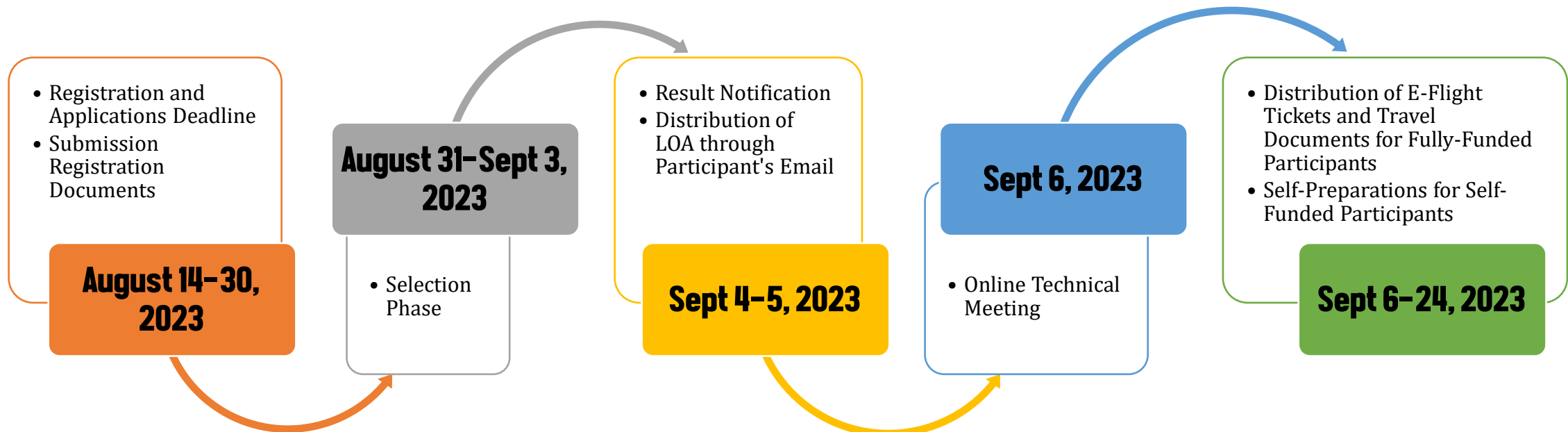

Participant Eligibility & Registration Scheme

Fully-Funded Participant

International University Students:

Undergraduate students from various academic disciplines, such as social sciences, environmental studies, engineering, business, law, and humanities, who are passionate about sustainable development and making a positive impact in the world.

Self-Funded Participant

International University Students: Undergraduate students from various academic disciplines, such as social sciences, environmental studies, engineering, business, law, and humanities, who are passionate about sustainable development and making a positive impact in the world.

Young Researchers: Early-career researchers and scholars with an interest in the SDGs, poverty eradication, quality education, and gender equality, and who have conducted relevant research or projects in these fields.

International Participants: Students and professionals including lecturer from various countries and cultural backgrounds to promote diverse perspectives and global collaboration.

Funding Criteria & Conditions



Specific Information for Fully-Funded Participants:

- Participants under the Fully Funded scheme will be required to submit an essay in English following the program's theme, "Navigating SDGs and Culture Across Borders: Empowering Student Changemakers". The essay should address the participant's understanding of the chosen Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) (Goal No. 1, Goal No. 4, or Goal No. 5) and present innovative ideas and solutions to accelerate progress towards achieving the SDGs' targets. Students are required to present their essays in front of the audience.
- Students are required to present their essays in front of the audience.
- Twenty (20) participants with the best essays aligned with the program's theme and criteria will be selected for the Fully Funded scheme, providing them with an exceptional opportunity to attend the UGEO 2023 Program with all expenses covered.

Funding Criteria & Conditions



Essay Criteria

1. Clarity of thought and presentation: The essay should be well-structured, coherent, and clearly convey the participant's ideas.
2. Originality and creativity: The essay should demonstrate fresh perspectives and innovative thinking in addressing the chosen SDG's challenges.
3. Alignment with the program's objectives: The essay should reflect the participant's commitment to making a positive impact in their community and contributing to the UGEO 2023 Program's mission.
4. Academic and writing proficiency: The essay should showcase the participant's ability to articulate their thoughts effectively and demonstrate a good grasp of the chosen SDG's context and relevant research.

Funding Criteria & Conditions

Fully-Funded participants will benefit from the comprehensive coverage of expenses associated with the program as outlined below:

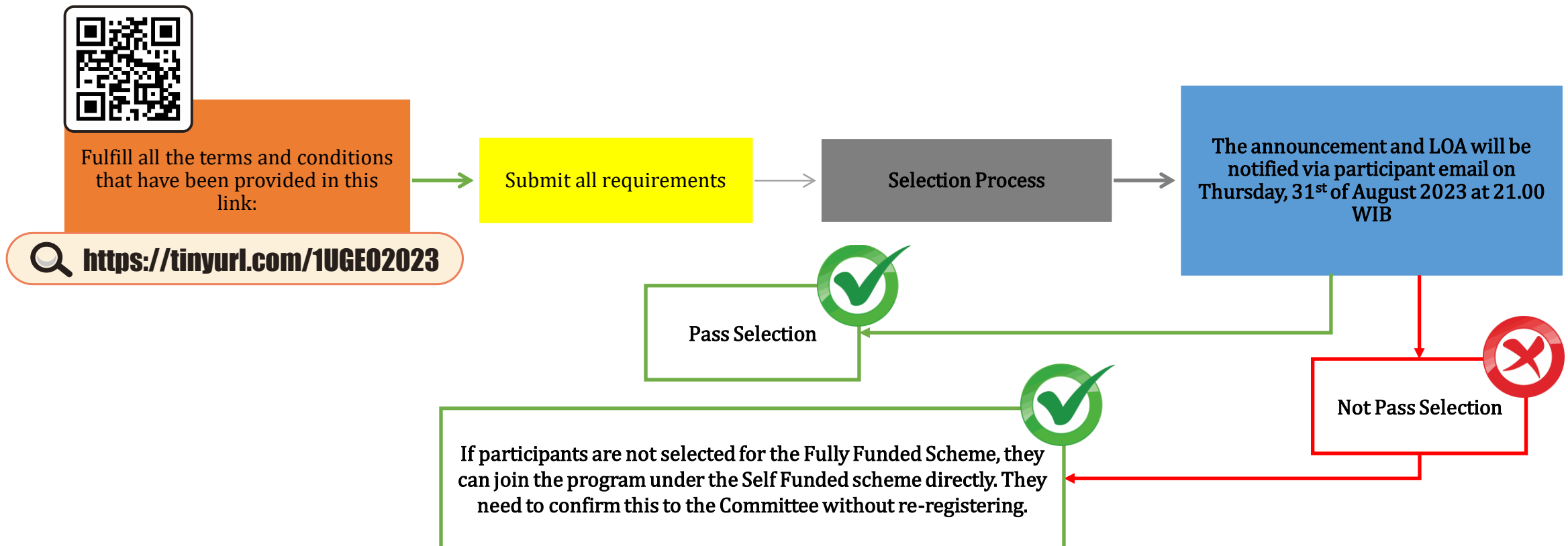
